DESCRIPTION

Huell Classic is a newly released hop variety, formerly known as 2013/017/107. Developed over many years at the Hop Research Center in Hüll, it was bred to improve climate resilience while preserving traditional noble hop characters. Huell Classic delivers refined, delicate aromas expected of classic German noble hops and is well suited as a replacement for traditional varieties such as Hersbrucker, Perle, and Tradition.
